### **RULE AND CODE OF CONDUCT:**

- You can register individually or in a team consisting of 1-4 members.
- Registration form must be filled completely without any false information.
- It is the participant's responsibility to have a stable internet connection. Dealing with any discontinuity in the event on the participant's side is not the organizers responsibility.
- All submitted entries would be checked for plagiarism and appropriate action will be taken if any found.
- Entries for the second round will be judged on the basis of Logical Flow, Analytical Reasoning, Innovative solution and presentation.
- Participants can only submit once for a selected problem statement and can attempt the quiz only once. Any extra submissions or quiz attempts could result in disqualification.

 It is compulsory that the team leader has an active email-ID for communication.

 Participants are advised to be present at the respective meeting platforms in advance to avoid last-minute hassles. Any request for a delay will not be entertained.

 Any anomaly must be informed well in advance so that necessary steps can be taken to resolve it beforehand.

 The organizing team reserves the right to change or modify any of the rules.

### **FAQs**

### 1. Who all are eligible to participate in the Ideathon?

**Ans** - Any undergraduate student, irrespective of location in India, their college, branch, language or gender can participate.

## 2. Can only girls / women participate?

**Ans** - No, any student irrespective of the gender they identify themselves as, is allowed to participate. The problem statements are related to women, but anybody with an idea can participate.

### 3. What is the maximum number of participants in a team allowed?

**Ans** - A minimum of an individual and maximum of four members are allowed to be in a team.

#### 4. How do we submit our ideas?

Ans - Submissions are required to be made on the unstop platform. The teams are encouraged to submit a video presenting a demo of what they have built along with the link to the GitHub repository and the hosted link (optional). Further submission guidelines can be found here - ideate.ieeenitb.com

## 5. Is it necessary to host your solution?

**Ans** - No, a video explanation is necessary for the presentation, and if they decide to implement something, they have the choice to include hosting or GitHub as additional components.

### 6. What is the last date of submission?

**Ans** - The deadline of submission is Oct 29, 2023 at 11:59 PM (Video submissions). Adhere to the deadline strictly. Any delay will not be considered for the evaluation.

# 7. What will be the judging criteria?

Ans - You will be judged based on the innovation of your idea and also on what you've built and its practical use. A complete and clear Idea presentation is one of the many factors you will be judged on. Other judging criteria are subject to IEEE MSB's concern and are not disclosed.

### 8. What is the prize worth?

**Ans** - The winning teams will be awarded prizes worth 5K. The winners and prizes, unless not specified otherwise, will be awarded solely based on the decision of the judging panel.

## 9. Do I need to pay any money to register for the Ideathon?

**Ans** - No. You do not have to pay anything to anyone to register your team.
